October 20, 2021

The meeting was called to order on October 20, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. in the Lindsay-Strathmore Cemetery District office by Director Dennis Medders. In addition to Director Medders, in attendance were Cemetery Manager Rebecca Morales, Director Dale Rains and Director Jeff Tienken.

Director Dennis Medders made the motion that the September 20, 2021 minutes be approved. Director Rains seconded the motion. With all in favor, the minutes were approved.

There were no public comments.

The directors reviewed and paid the current bills. Also examined were the ones that had required payment prior to the meeting.

The total bills for September 2021 were: Salaries \$20,183.75; Water/Grove Care \$8,216.79; Medical Insurance \$1,385.08; Remaining expenses \$24,499.87.

Cemetery income for August was \$90,197.25 (included is the burial and pre-need income, endowment, the interests for the two Bank of Sierra accounts). The Tritten account balance was \$48,359.34.

The Tulare County third quarter Treasurer's Report was available for the Board members to review.

The total interments for August was (20). At Lindsay there were 11) full burials, (8) cremations and (1) baby.

Mrs. Morales presented the October Manager's Report.

**Old Business:**

**Staffing** – Rebecca Morales left the room and the directors discussed salary review & adjustments for manager (Rebecca Morales) and secretary (Yuri Rodriguez). Rebecca Morales was called back to the meeting, and informed that Rebecca would receive an increase of wages of \$5.00 an hour which brought her salary up to \$23.00 per hour. Yuri Rodriguez received a wage increase of \$2.00 an hour which brought her salary up to \$15.00 an hour. A motion was made by Director Dale Rains and a second by Director Jeff Tienken, with all in favor.

**Southern California Billing Error:** - The Directors were given billing copies that Angela Tipton from Lindsay-Strathmore Memorial District had gathered to look over. Yuri Rodriguez, secretary, had gone over the copies and came up with the same amount \$9902.04. A motion was made by Director Jeff Tienken and a second by Director Dale Rains, with all in favor, to issue a check to Lindsay-Strathmore Memorial District for \$9902.04.

**Zeronox:** - Manager Morales reported that the Zeronox will probably be delivered in late spring.

**Addition 15:** - Rebecca Morales reported that some grass is growing in Addition 15. Directors decided that we should not water Addition 15 at the present time due to water shortage/drought.


**New Business:** - Rebecca informed the directors of the three estimates she received for trimming the trees from Unlimited Tree Service, Co. (\$20,510.00), General Tree Service, Inc. (\$38,950.00) and Jacob Ruiz Tree Service (\$95,800.00). All three were very high, so it was suggested that Rebecca obtain three more estimates.

**Gas & Diesel:** - Mrs. Morales informed the directors that she checked gas & diesel prices at a couple gas stations. She asked if the grounds men could use the visa card to get gas & diesel at Fast Trip gas station as the two other stations in town that we were able to use the RVJ card were a lot higher in prices. The board agreed to this. They did state that Rebecca keep a record of gas & diesel used for off road vehicles as well as grounds only vehicles & equipment (can get tax rebate).

On a motion by Director Medders and second by Director Rains, with all in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
