APRIL 20, 2022

The meeting was called to order on April 20, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. in the Lindsay-Strathmore Cemetery District office by Director Dennis Medders. In addition to Director Dennis Medders, in attendance were Cemetery Manager Rebecca Morales, Director Jeff Tienken and Director Dale Rains.

Director Dale Rains made the motion that the March 16, 2022 minutes be approved. Director Jeff Tienken seconded the motion, with all in favor, the minutes were approved.

The directors reviewed and paid the current bills, and also examined were the ones that had required payment prior to the meeting.

The total bills for March 2022 were: Salaries \$17,024.50; Water/Grove Care \$3,601.79; Medical Insurance \$2,077.62. Remaining expenses \$19,899.14. Cemetery income for March was \$78,994.92 (included is the burial and pre-need income, endowment, the interest for the two Bank of Sierra accounts and Tulare County transfer of funds for \$60,000.00). The Tritten account balance was \$48,371.40.

The Tulare County ninth quarter Treasurer's Report was available for the Board members to review.

Total interments for March were (12). At Lindsay there were (6) full burials and (6) cremations.

Rebecca presented the Cemetery Manager's report. Director Jeff Tienken presented his letter of resignation as a board member. We have an application from Terry Tredway and will possibly have another from Eddie Smith (Webb, Sanders & Smith). Disinterment of Mr.

One lady showed up to the meeting at this time. She waited until old & new business were taken care of, and then asked if she could place flowers in the vases on her parent's grave. She was told "yes of course and they would not be removed until they looked old".

OLD BUSINESS:

INTERNET & PHONE SERVICE: The proposal to have Oacy's as our internet & phone service was presented to the board members. Director Dale Rains motioned that we get a site survey, Director Jeff Tienken seconded it, with all in favor, Oacy's will be called about getting a site survey.

NICHE WALLS:

Two estimates were given to the board members to look over, one from Kyber Niche Company which was \$99,750.00 for two double sided walls (120 niches in each wall), and the other was from Premier Columbaria which was \$33,183.00 for

one niche wall. Board members asked that Rebecca check into getting more estimates as these prices were really steep.

ADDITION 15:

Kaylor Landscaping came out and suggested to Jaime that the wiring for the sprinkler system be rewired. Kaylor Landscaping offered to do this. Board members suggested that Rebecca contact Bob Ruffa, but as of this time, Jaime did the rewiring and it seemed to work.

OFFICE CAMERA:

Board members were given estimates from Giotto's, Ring & Blink cameras for the front of the office & behind for the garage attached to the office. Giotto's was \$12,664.52, Blink was \$114.99, plus \$10.00 a month, and Ring was \$419.99, plus \$20.00 a month (found on Amazon). Director Dale Rains motioned that Rebecca check at Costco for the Ring, Jeff Tienken seconded it, with all in favor, she will check pricing with Costco.

NEW BUSINESS:


CHEVY TRUCK:
