

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) NOTICE

TO MINIMIZE THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS
THE FOLLOWING WILL BE IMPLEMENTED AT THE
LINDSAY-STRATHMORE PUBLIC CEMETERY DISTRICT
Effective 6/29/2020

Office/Clerical/General Information

- The cemetery office is now open, but a **mask is required** before entering and/or when conducting your business.
A maximum of two (2) family members or friends are to be in the office at one time.
 - Please use hand sanitizer prior to signing paperwork.
- Burial site selection, signing interment authorization, making a payment, etc. must be done by appointment only.

- Burial site selection should preferably be limited to two (2) individuals & out of consideration for our grounds crew and other visitors, with a mask on.
- After choosing the gravesite, the person issuing the burial rights will need to make an appointment to sign the Interment paperwork and/or to make a payment. Again, no more than (2) individuals.
- Preneed arrangements have been resumed as of 6/29/20, but an appointment should be made before coming to the office.
- Per cemetery policy, payment can only be made by personal check, cashier's check or money order. **NO CASH** will be accepted.

Interments

- Graveside services **will be no longer than 30 minutes.**
- We are requesting that families limit the number of people at the gravesite so that there is enough room to comply with the social distancing requirements of 6 feet in-between each person. Masks should be worn.
- Chairs or shade coverings (due to extreme heat) may be brought in by families for the elderly or those with medical conditions as long as there is social distancing and the time limit of 30 minutes is adhered to.
- The burial staff will not come to the grave site to proceed with the lowering and closing of the grave until all the family members have left the grounds. The family/friends may observe the closing of the grave from a considerable distance within their cars if they desire.

Due to the safety of visitors and staff, the cemetery grounds men may at any time halt the interment due to lack of compliance of the above guidelines
