**MARCH 2023 BOARD MEETING**

The meeting was called to order on March 15, 2023 at 4:40 p.m. in the Lindsay-Strathmore Cemetery District office by Director Eddie Smith. In addition to Director Smith in attendance were Director Terry Tredway and Cemetery Manager Rebecca Morales. Director Dale Rains was out of town.

Director Smith made the motion that the February 2023 minutes be approved, Director Terry Tredway seconded the motion. With all in favor, the minutes were approved.

There were no public comments.

The current bills were reviewed and paid by the directors. Also examined were the bills that required payment prior to the meeting. The total bills for February were: Salaries \$11,939.00; Medical Insurance \$692.55; Water/Grove Care \$9,488.07; remaining expenses \$15,506.90. Income for February was \$54,782.00. The Tritten Account balance was \$46,145.14.

Accessible at the meeting for the Board members to review were the (3) county balance sheets for the Pre-Need, Endowment and General Accounts. The Tulare County 8th quarter Treasurer's Reports were also available.

Rebecca Morales presented the March Cemetery Manager's Report (attached to the minutes).

Interments for February were: Lindsay (10) full burials and (5) cremation burials.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**ADDITION 15:** Rebecca showed the board members a map for the new Addition 15. They questioned about having more upright locations than what was on the map. Jaime, lead grounds man, will be re-doing the map to see if we can get more upright locations in Addition 15. He is planning on zig zagging upright marker locations among the flat marker locations, and will be able to rope off upright & flat marker locations to get a better visual after we obtain survey markers to mark off blocks.



SETTING HEADSTONES FOR OUT OF TOWN MONUMENT COMPANIES: Ken Lambert, who sets headstones for Woodville Cemetery, was contacted, and agreed to set headstones that are from Fresno Monument companies, etc. that will not set headstones at our cemetery. Jamie Garza, lead grounds man, stated that he could also set headstones when needed.

FRAZIER VALLEY CEMETERY IRRIGATION: Director Eddie Smith went to Frazier Valley Cemetery and is working on a sprinkler system to be done by himself and grounds men.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:33 p.m. The next regular Board meeting will be held at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 19, 2023.
